# SERMON OUTLINE

## **When the Spirit Comes with Power: Making Noise** **Part VII** **Acts 1:12-14; Acts 2:1-4, 14-21, 42-47**

The Lovely Sound Of Pentecost. What caused the sound? You are arriving late at an Ohio State Football game. You are not quite in the stadium. You hear the roar as it begins to build. First it is slow and quiet, but it builds, and continues to grow louder until you hear it last for about ten seconds ....loud....constant.....never ending.....a roar that could only mean one thing as it resounds through the stadium and beyond.....You have just missed a touchdown on the opening kickoff. Now, let me ask you, what caused the roar, what led to the noise?

Everyone in the Stadium had witnessed the same thing, and the One thing that they all had seen, the One thing they all were focused on, the One person they all connected with.....this caused the roar. The guy with the ball.....the sound is the result of the common focus, not the people.....

Acts 2:1 says, they were all together in one place. And then there was noise. They all heard it. They all shared in it. And they all were affected by it, so much so that each one of them begins to join into the sound of the wind by speaking in tongues. It was like one big roar coming up for all the world to hear, all the world to see, all the world to participate in.....Now, you are outside. You hear the sound. You sense something incredible is happening. Let me ask you once again? What caused the roar? What caused the sounds you hear?

-Once again, it was people joined together focused on One Thing, One event, One person. And the sound is the result of the common focus, not the people.....

-There is only one thing which brings revival in the church. It's not a web site, its not an evangelistic out reach program, its not care groups, its not a well done sermon, its not a Christmas cantata, its not trunk or treat, its not a well done bible Study, its not the gifts and talents of our people. There is one thing and one thing alone which leads to a display of God's Power, which leads to the moving and out pouring of God's Spirit.

The Spirit comes with Power when God's people call upon his name.....

*Acts 1:14* They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

*Acts. 2:21:* Salvation can only be discovered when people humbly call upon the Lord.....

*Acts 2:* <sup>42</sup>They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread **and to prayer.** <sup>43</sup>Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. <sup>44</sup>All the believers were together and had everything in common. <sup>45</sup>Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. <sup>46</sup>Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, <sup>47</sup>praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
